

# What enables the Program?

Cooperative Purchasing

"NJ State Cooperative Purchasing (N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29) Local contracting units may, without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services from designated cooperative contracts through the New Jersey Division of Purchase and Property." (NJLM.org)

## Who May Use State Cooperative Purchasing Contracts?

The Public Purchasing Entities listed below are eligible to use State Cooperative Purchasing Contracts.

- Municipalities
- Counties
- School Districts
- Volunteer Fire Departments
- Volunteer First Aid and Rescue Squads
- County and State Colleges
- Independent Authorities
- Quasi-State Agencies
- Independent Institutions of Higher Education

# What enables the Program? F-Procurement

- LFN 2021-18 announced the "Final Adopted e-Procurement Regulations: Goods, Services, and Public Works Contracts
- NJSTART software meets the requirements of these regulations and is available to New Jersey counties, municipalities, and schools at no cost to those entities



Options for Purchasing from State Contracts in NJSTART

### 1 – Simple Search

- Search and locate items based on keywords.
- Enter into internal systems for order processing.



# 2 – Create Shopping Cart & Printable Requisition

- Select the items and quantities.
- Add to a shopping cart.
- Auto-generate NJSTART requisition form.
- Print and enter into internal system for order processing.
- Run a report and retrieve an excel file for batch entry and reporting.



# 3 – Send Order Electronically to Vendor

- Route requisition for approvals in NJSTART.
- Upon approval, PO autogenerated and sent to supplier.
- PCards can be used to pay for order.\*
- Print the PO for records.
- Run a report and retrieve an excel file for batch entry and reporting.

4 – send order electronically to vendor & transmit order to ERP/financial system\*

- Select the items and quantities.
- Add to a shopping cart.
- Auto-generate NJSTART requisition form.
- Print and enter into internal system for order processing.
- Run a report and retrieve an excel file for batch entry and reporting.
