






Engineering Team Structure

Allows us to focus on customer-driven needs while also building out innovation




Technical Debt

Ability to dedicate time to cleaning up code that prevents future enhancements or was a quick patch with a more robust solution that has been delayed to be implemented.



Complex Code Gaps

Due to the complexity of the code base there are occasional need for deeper analysis to determine the proper fix for sporadic issues. The need to delve into complex use cases is provided.



Process Improvement

Identify issues due to processes or policies that cause disconnection to the intention of a particular solution or integration.

Complex workflows and data transitions are evaluated to arrive to a resolution.



Recurring Issues

Provide solutions for issues that happen over and over again. Often these issues are quickly solved but requires more time to identify root cause and a more complex solution in order to keep from happening again.









