### Who is Periscope?

NJSTART is the State of New Jersey's e-Procurement system and was developed in partnership with **Periscope**, **powered by mdf commerce**\*. The Marketplace Program (Program), a component of NJSTART, facilitates the process of selling to New Jersey governments.

The State of New Jersey is partnering with us to manage the Program for both New Jersey agencies, cooperative purchasing participants, and vendors such as yourself.

We strive to work with vendors that have fully-executed contracts with the State of New Jersey to maximize their contract sales and meet their state contract related business goals, regardless of size or scope.




### What is the Marketplace Program?

The Marketplace software is an integral component of the NJSTART eProcurement system. It allows suppliers to load product/service catalogs related to their contracts with the state.

Once catalogs are in place, state users and cooperative purchasing participants may use the Marketplace to search for state contracts, shop from them (shopping basket functionality), and generate POs that will be transmitted to the supplier electronically.

## 6 Steps to Success

After your contract is awarded or amended, these 6 simple steps will ensure your participation in NJSTART is as successful as possible.



#### STEP 2 Upload Your Catalog

Our software lets you load and manage your catalog, including item details and images from your state-approved contract.



### STEP 4 Market Your Contract

By working with you to promote your contract, the NJSTART Team helps get your contract in front of the right buyers.



### **STEP 6**Quarterly Reporting

Done online through Reconciler, NJSTART's easy-to-use online reporting tool.



With personalized training, handy guides, and short step-by-step tutorial videos we make it easy to get started.



### **STEP 3**Define Your Goals

The flexibility of the NJSTART system means that you can define your own goals. We'll work with you to meet them.



### STEP 5 Receive Orders

Orders from state agencies are sent to you immediately, directly through the site.

# Convenience Fee & Quarterly Reporting

Effective September 6, 2022, a new regulation extending a mandatory **1% convenience fee** to contracted suppliers for applicable State contracts was enacted.

Convenience fees to fund procurement operations, cooperative programs, and systems are common across the U.S. These fees are a way to **improve services** to the supplier community and the state.

Participating State contract suppliers are required to report their net sales on a quarterly basis and pay their convenience fee directly using NJSTART.
